**Emergency Vehicle Access to all areas of Jubilee Wood from the Car Park**

HAZARDS	WHO MIGHT BE HARMED	CONTROL MEASURES/PRECAUTIONS
General Forestry operations	Forestry workers, volunteers, members of the general public	Banksmen, warning signs and barrier tape as required
Slips and trips or falls on uneven or slippery ground	Forestry workers, volunteers	Tidy site, adequate safety footwear. Cancel/curtail work in adverse weather
Underground services	Forestry workers, volunteers	High Pressure Gas pipeline identified by marker posts on site
Public Access Tracks	Pedestrians being struck by forestry machinery, tractor or falling trees or branches	Banksmen, warning signs and barrier tape as required. Qualified machine operators
First Aid	All persons	Comprehensive First Aid kit in JW container. Emergency worker first aid kits to be carried at all times during forestry operations
Illness from pre-existing medical conditions	Forestry workers, volunteers	Duty Officer to confirm with participants any medical conditions or medication
Risk of injury and infection from cuts, splinters or foreign bodies	Forestry workers, volunteers	All participants to wear appropriate PPE, long sleeved tops and trousers, safety footwear where required
Risk of back or muscular injury moving heavy objects	Forestry workers, volunteers	All participants to use correct manual handling techniques. Do not move anything beyond your capabilities
Injury from tools, materials or other equipment	Forestry workers, volunteers	Safe working practices to be followed, suitable PPE worn. Tools and materials to be stored safely in designated areas
Poisoning or skin damage from hazardous or toxic plant material	Volunteers	Duty Officer to identify and mark any hazardous plant material prior to activity
Falling tree or debris	Forestry workers, volunteers	Create a defined exclusion zone for all except authorised tree workers with suitable PPE and hard hats must be worn
Manual handling while brushing and logging	Forestry workers, volunteers	All site workers must be authorised and directed in safe manual handling by the Banksmen or Duty Officer
Puncture injury from thorns or other sharps	Forestry workers, volunteers	Sturdy trousers or overalls, boots, leather gloves, kneepads where appropriate
Transporting sharp tools	Forestry workers, volunteers	Ensure blades are guarded or sheathed and carried facing down and away from the body
